Agenda of Captains Meeting Minutes

Wednesday March 21, 2018; 7:00pm

- I. Call to order 7:02pm
 - a. Clubs Present: Pigs Trotters, MCC, Central Saanich, Metchosin, Sticky Wicket, Beagle, UVIC, WM, Ross Bay and Stonewallers
- II. 2018 Schedule handout and playing conditions
 - a. Schedule discussed – first week at Beacon Hill may have some changes, please be aware and await confirmation asap
 - b. Mondays at Windsor Park beginning June 18 (to accommodate VISAS)
 - c. Wicket Maidens to play Tue evenings @ Beacon Hill. Practices scheduled Fridays @ Beacon Hill, field availability permitting.
- III. Team Dues are set at \$550 this season. \$500 goes to the VDCA from each team, the remaining will be for balls, tournaments and awards for the season.
- IV. Cricket balls for each team
 - a. Stock of pink balls to be distributed before start of season. Executive will be ordering a different colour this season, may trial orange or neon green. 1 new ball to be used each match.
- V. Playoffs
 - i. Top 3 teams from each tier will advance to their respective playoffs. Second place team will play third place team in a preliminary final. The winner of that match will play the first-place team in the final. Same format as last season
- VI. Rules to be discussed (please see attached updated playing conditions)
 - a. Six-yard mark to be painted on all fields for bowling start line.
 - i. This will be done periodically by the executive or teams participating on the Monday games
 - b. Scorecards will be required to be completed, or a clear photo sent in, by the Sunday night of the week played or a loss of one point will be deducted
 - c. Extras will be counted on a delivery basis. If a player bowls four deliveries of wides or no balls total (1 wide, 3 no balls; 2 wides, 2 no balls; etc) the following delivery that is deemed to be a wide or no ball will immediately be called a dead ball and no runs will be tallied, additionally the batsmen cannot be dismissed. The bowler will continue bowling until 6 legitimate deliveries have been bowled.

- d. Eligibility for playoffs will be 4 games throughout both halves of the season. No eligibility requirements to play in the second half of the season. 4 games voted in unanimously.
- e. Registered players will only play for one club throughout the season.
 - i. If any inimical circumstances result in a player requesting to play for another club, they must email the league secretary for review.
- f. Stats players will be 1 on game night. A tight vote 7-4 with the executive committee abstaining from the vote.
- g. Change to Wicket Maidens playing conditions – WMs will always bat second. First innings total is divided by 2 which becomes WMs target score. Games will not be contested for points.
- h. Additional rules clarified on the updated playing conditions, attached with the minutes

- A)** Must be paid in full by the first game
- B)** Player registration deposit of \$250 must be paid at or before your 1st game.
- C)** 75 orange balls will be ordered, remaining pink and white will be distributed as well
- D)** Colts are not a side this season; however, SMUS is a strong possibility
 - a. SMUS to play every Monday against a team playing on the Thursday of the same week
 - b. When the field is ready for use, updated schedule to be sent out
